CD Project

These are very simple ornaments to make for your tree.

Get a used CD

You can use scrapbook paper, old Christmas cards, material, or anything else that you would like. I used a glue stick and also ribbon.



This is what they looked like done. I just added the ribbon through the hole in the center of the CD.



Christmas Wine Nite Lite Bottle

This is another very simple craft project.

You can get wine bottles from the recycle place for nothing. Recycle is good.

I get the smallest string of lights from Dollar Store I think a couple of dollars. Then find any kind of Christmas decoration to finish off your bottle. Stick your string of lights inside and light up your night. They have different color of glass wine bottles so experiment on them.

I always top off with raffia, ribbon, or something similar.

Beaded Tree

You need a Styrofoam ball or cone for this project.

Beads of your choice. Elmer's white glue and a pot or container. I also had straight pins.



I put glue on the cone where I was going to place a bead, then I stick the straight pin through the bead and cone to hold the bead in place where I had placed the glue. Just keep working around or up and down until you have the cone filled.



As you work on the cone this is what it will look like. As you can see I still have more to add to the cone but you get the idea.

Newspaper Bird Ornament

This is another easy project but very neat and unique. I received one for a swap and she had three layers of the newspaper print instead of one like I found on the Net. With hers she curled the wings around a pencil and it looked really good. Here's a picture of the one she made. Just glue the three layers together at the body and leave the tail free to curl outward a little. You could use scrapbook paper for this as well.



Pattern for bird.

If you do three layers just cut three pieces of each pattern.

This pattern is a little different but I'm sure you could find hers.

I made one from the pattern on the next page and I know for sure next year my tree will be decorated with birds and nature. I just love them and they only take a minute to make.

I made two layers for the body with the scrap book paper folded with the wrong side together.

Pattern for Bird



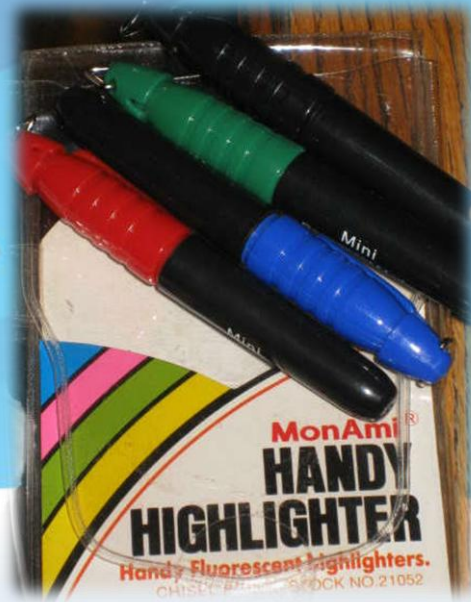

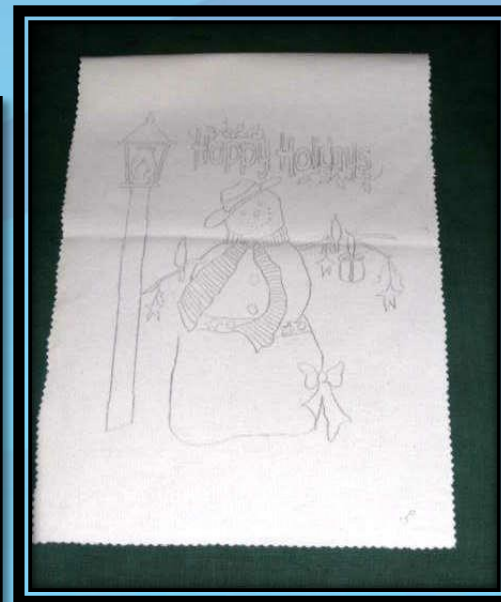
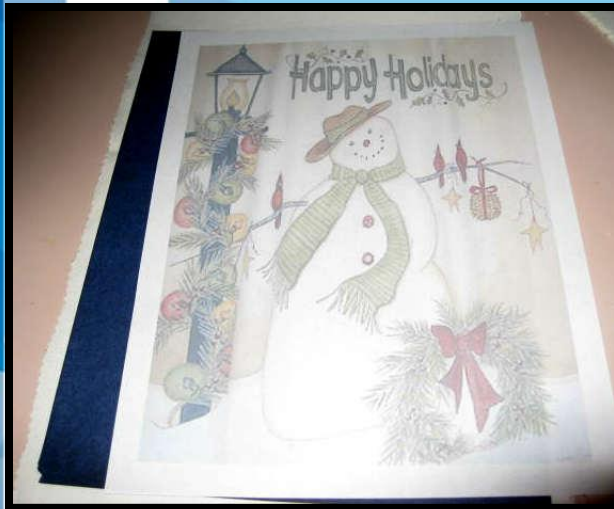


Snowman Banner

This is another easy project and one that the kids can help you with. They look complicated but all you need is markers, some canvas material, ribbon, and a dowel rod. A picture downloaded from net remember most are copyright so use for personal use only and some carbon paper.



This is what the picture looks like after you copy it to the canvas.



I use the markers and color in just like with a coloring book. I put ribbon around the edge and sewed a hem for the dowel or you can glue canvas to the dowel rod and you can glue ribbon to top, bottom, and sides. Add beads, ribbon, embellishments of your choice.
